8	(a) In General.—Section 3679 of title 38, United
9	States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-

13	disapprove a course of education provided by a public in-
14	stitution of higher education unless the institution charges
15	tuition and fees for a veteran at the same rate as the insti-

17	tution is located, regardless of the veteran's State of resi-

19	"(2) The Secretary shall notify the State approving
20	agency of the Secretary's disapproval of a course of edu-
21	cation under this subsection.".
22	(b) TREATMENT OF ENROLLED BENEFITS RECIPI-
23	ENTS.—
24	(1) IN GENERAL.—In the case of a veteran or
25	eligible person who is enrolled before August 1,
26	2014, in a course of education provided by a public

institution of higher education that was approved under chapter 36 of title 38, United States Code, at the time of the initial enrollment of the veteran or eligible person but that is disapproved by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs or the Secretary's designee by reason of subsection (c) of section 3679 of such title, as added by subsection (a) of this section, the Secretary shall treat such institution as an institution that is approved under such chapter for purposes of the laws administered by the Secretary with respect to the veteran or eligible person until the veteran or eligible person completes the course of education in which the veteran or eligible person is enrolled.

(2) TERMINATION.—

- (A) LIMITATION.—Except as provided in subparagraph (B), the Secretary of Veterans Affairs may not treat an institution of higher education as an approved institution under paragraph (1) after August 1, 2018.
- (B) WAIVER.—The Secretary may waive the limitation under subparagraph (A) if the Secretary determines such a waiver is appropriate.
