Mr. VanBemmel currently serves as the Civilian Deputy for Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA), Services Directorate (SE). Mr. VanBemmel has a diverse technology background working for both the DoD and commercial industry. He began his career with government service in the US Air Force as an Air Traffic Controller.
