Elizabeth Angerman is a member of the Senior Executive Service and is the Executive Director of the new Unified Shared Service Management Office in GSA, responsible for working with the new governance board to implement the enterprise-wide vision for mission-support functions across government. Prior to GSA, Beth was named the Executive Director of the Office of Financial Innovation and Transformation (FIT) in the Treasury Department in August 2013 to address the need for greater efficiency and transparency in the Federal financial environment.
