Serves as the Command's principal, senior level advisor on the strategic direction, objectives, and supervision of all issues in command, control, communications, computers and information management (C4IM). Mr. Bradford is the single command-wide

responsible official whose primary duties involve the execution, improved design, modernization, acquisition, use, sharing, performance and termination of information resources. He provides technical direction to the senior leaders of the AMC Information Technology community and oversight of the delivery of all C4IM services and enterprise applications. In this capacity, Mr. Bradford directs the information component of national power for AMC's strategic advantage.

Prior to this position, Mr. Bradford served as Deputy to the Commanding General and Senior Technical Director of US Army Network Enterprise Technology Command (NETCOM) responsible to the CG NETCOM for DODIN Operations, including operating, managing, and defending the Army's enterprise network globally. Mr. Bradford exercised oversight and technical control for a command of 17,000 personnel dispersed across four Theaters of Operation (Pacific, Europe, Continental US, Southwest Asia). He was responsible for the operations, engineering, and technical solutions used by NETCOM in support of the Army's global operating and generating forces. Mr. Bradford led the operational engineering and design activities in the command, infusing the latest technology into the Army enterprise network and supporting defensive Cyber and network operations. He served as the Senior Civilian in the Command and was responsible for Civilian well-being, training, career, and mission-related activities world-wide.
