Challenge

A national public health agency needed to modernize their systems and processes but lacked proper visibility into their DevOps processes and architecture.

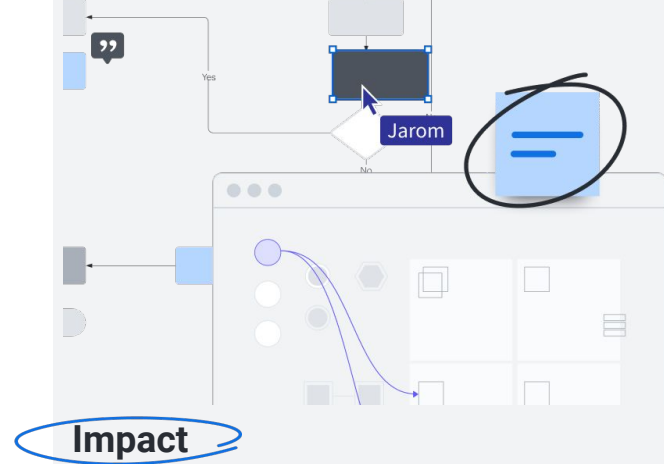
The agency's modernization efforts were delayed as teams struggled with misalignment, uncertainty, and inefficient development processes.
