

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. How does the week-long Fedstival timeline work?

Fedstival will take place from October 3 through October 7 at various locations throughout Washington, DC, and will feature events during the day and at night, Monday through Friday. The week-long schedule with multiple events per day makes it easier for federal employees to attend the events on the topics that they care about most without impacting their workflow throughout the week. A series of editorial events will anchor the daytime events Tuesday through Thursday, and Fedstival will culminate at the end of the week with Bold Friday, where we will celebrate innovative teams that are making change in the federal government with a series of Ted-Talk styled presentations.

2. When will specific locations for Fedstival be announced?

3. Is there a fee to register for Fedstival?

There is **no cost** associated with registering for Fedstival. Both government and industry personnel can register for this event, free of charge.
