Ms. Corey E. Cooke serves as the Acting Regional Administrator for the Northwest/Arctic Region of the U.S. General Services Administration (GSA). As Regional Administrator, Ms. Cooke oversees GSA's operations in Alaska, Idaho, Oregon, and Washington providing workspace, telecommunications, information technology, vehicles, and thousands of other goods and services to federal agencies in the area. The Region features a federal inventory of 508 owned and leased buildings, more than 460 employees, and a total budget of more than \$362.7 million annually.

Ms. Cooke previously served as Senior Advisor to the Administrator for Cyber and Technology at GSA. In that capacity, she provided strategic guidance on policies and legislation related to GSA's expanding technology transformation portfolio, including work to establish the Program Management Office (PMO) to oversee administration of the Technology Modernization Fund (TMF), and the development of the Report to the President on Federal IT Modernization as required by Executive Order 13800, as well as implementation of its recommendations.

Prior to joining the agency, Ms. Cooke served in several positions in the U.S. House of Representatives, including Counsel and Deputy Parliamentarian for the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform and Counsel on the U.S. House of Representatives Committee on Small Business.

She earned a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Massachusetts, Amherst and a J.D. from the University of New Hampshire School of Law.
