Trevor Norris began his Federal career in 1999 as a Presidential Management Intern with the Department of the Navy. His first assignment was in executive resources and leadership development, where he helped manage Navy's Senior Executive Service (SES) personnel program. Over the course of ten years on the Secretary of the Navy's staff, he took on increasingly complex roles in a wide array of functions including human resources, budget formulation, total force manpower, and special programs.
