Walton Francis pioneered the comparison of health insurance plans from a consumer perspective, as the principal author of the annual CHECKBOOK's *Guide to Health Plans for Federal Employees*. The Guide has been described as "the bible for federal health plan hunters" and shows which plans can save employees, annuitants, and federal agencies (who pay most of the premiums) thousands of dollars. The Guide is available both online and on paper, both to federal agencies for access by employees and to individual employees and annuitants. Walton has written and testified before Congress on the performance of the Federal Employees Health Benefits and Medicare programs. He is a member of the National Academy of Social Insurance.
