ORDER FOR CONSOLIDATION

On June 18, 2018, this Court held a teleconference with the parties in this case and the parties in *American Federation of Government Employees v. Trump, et al.*, 18-cv-1261. During that teleconference, this Court discussed the possibility of consolidating these cases, and neither the government nor the plaintiffs objected to consolidation. Given that these cases are currently at similar early procedural stages, and because the claims in each case arise from a common nexus of fact and involve several identical legal issues, *see* Fed. R. Civ. P. 42(a)(2) (authorizing consolidation when multiple actions “involve a common question of law or fact”), it is hereby

ORDERED that the following cases are **CONSOLIDATED**: *American Federation of Government Employees, AFL-CIO v. Trump, et al.*, 18-cv-1261 and *National Federation of Federal Employees, FD1, IAMAW, AFL-CIO, et al. v. Trump,*

18-cv-1395. All filings in these consolidated cases shall be made only in the first-filed case, 18-cv-1261, and the Clerk is hereby directed to administratively close 18-cv-1395.
