SCHEDULING ORDER

On June 18, 2018, this Court held a teleconference with all of the parties involved in the above-entitled action, including the plaintiffs in *National Treasury Employees Union v. Trump, et al.*, 18-cv-1348, and in *National Federation of Federal Employees, FDI, IAMAW, AFL-CIO, et al. v. Trump*, 18-cv-1395, as well as AFSCME. During that call, the parties and this Court agreed upon an expedited briefing schedule to resolve this matter on the merits. Consistent with that agreement, it is hereby

ORDERED that the parties shall conform to the following expedited briefing schedule:

- a. Plaintiffs’ motion(s) for summary judgment shall be due on or before Monday, June 25, 2018.
- b. Defendants’ opposition and any cross-motion for summary judgment shall be due on or before Monday, July 16, 2018.

- c. Any replies by Plaintiffs in support of their motion(s) for summary judgment and in opposition to any pending cross-motion for summary judgment shall be due on or before Friday, July 20, 2018.
- d. Any reply in support of any cross-motion by Defendants' shall be due on or before Tuesday, July 24, 2018.
