Mr. Fowler, a 33-year veteran of the CIA, is currently on detail to the Department of State where he serves as the Chief Information Officer (CIO) for the Bureau of Intelligence and Research (INR), one of the 17 members of the Intelligence Community (IC). As CIO, Mr. Fowler overseas the full range of technology enabling operations for INR and the TS infrastructure supporting the Department.

A recognized innovator and pioneer across the IC, Mr. Fowler founded CIA's WIRe (papa WIRe), the PDB mobile program, and NGA's Globe and is now championing INR's development of its Tempo website for delivery of Intelligence at the Speed of Diplomacy.

Throughout his career, Mr. Fowler has supported and frequently served at the nexus of intelligence and decisionmaking. In the recent past, Mr. Fowler served as Special Assistant to the President and Senior Director of the White House Situation Room, as the Chief of Strategy for CIA, and as a member of the senior leadership team of the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA) where he led the Xperience Directorate. Mr. Fowler began the century as the Chief of CIA's Operations Center and assisted the establishment of the Department of Homeland Security. Mr. Fowler started his service to the nation in 1987 as an analyst at CIA covering Antarctica; an assignment he credits as being the foundation for his tenacity and innovation.

Mr. Fowler has been recognized with the National Intelligence Reform Medal, the Intelligence Medal of Merit, and Intelligence Commendation Medals. He is the very lucky husband of Ms. Brooke Christine Fowler and proud father of Evan and Lena Fowler.
