

## Maj. Gen. Jennifer Napper, U.S. Army, Retired Vice President, Army and Cyber Programs Perspecta Inc.

Jennifer Napper, vice president of Army and cyber programs in Perspecta's defense group, is responsible for leading the teams that support the company's U.S. Army and cyber accounts. She brings a wealth of military experience to this position having served as director of cybersecurity plans and policy for the U.S. Department of Defense Cyber Command. In this role she developed long-term campaign plans, strategy and policy while working within the interagency on National Policy for Cyberspace.
