Ken Ammon is a seasoned executive with a proven track record of driving venture backed security companies from an early stage through strategic acquisition.

Ken began working with CA Technologies when it acquired Xceedium, a privileged access management company, in 2015. Ken joined Xceedium as its chief strategy officer from Looking Glass Security, LLC, a consulting firm that advises corporations and private equity funds and Venture Capital investors on emerging security trends and technologies.

Prior to founding Looking Glass Security, Ken was founder and CEO of NetSec, a pioneer in the managed security service provider marketplace with global operations and customers including 7 of the global 10 largest corporations. After selling NetSec to Verizon Business Systems, he became a senior vice president with the communications and IT-solutions giant.

Prior to founding NetSec, Ken was with Trusted Computer Solutions, which has since been acquired by Raytheon.

Specializing in security matters relating to commercial enterprise and federal government markets, Ken has testified before the House Government Reform Committee on dramatic security vulnerabilities affecting sensitive government information and critical infrastructure. Ken also has served as an adjunct faculty member at the NSA's National Cryptologic School, where he was recognized with the Scientific Achievement Award.

He began his career in the U.S. Air Force, where he was a Captain assigned to the National Security Agency. Ken holds a patent for wireless intrusion detection methods.
