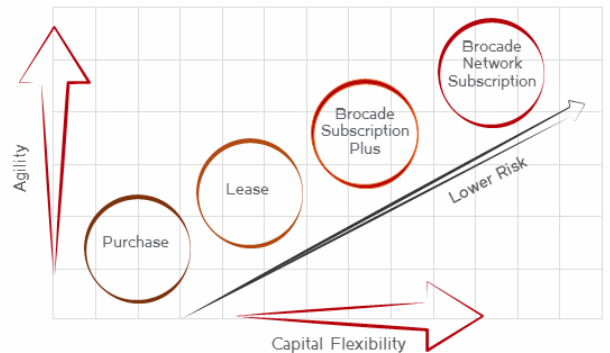


Figure 1. Brocade Network Acquisition Alternatives.
