This includes the integration of cutting-edge technologies, data sharing, and analytical techniques that are vital to U.S. national security to gain advantage against emerging counterintelligence threats.

Ms. Elinsky joined the ODNI in 2010, where she has held multiple leadership roles including positions to develop and oversee the creation of an inter-agency governance structure for Intelligence Community's (IC) IT modernization efforts, as well as mission management functions for national-level intelligence priorities.
