Leo Scanlon is the Deputy Chief Information Officer for the Department of Health and Human Services and is the HHS Senior Advisor for Healthcare Cybersecurity. He chairs the HHS Cybersecurity Working Group and is leading initiatives to build public-private partnerships to enhance cyber threat information sharing.

Prior to joining HHS, Leo served as the CISO for the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA). While at NARA, he put in place and matured the agency IT Security Program. In addition, he served as the agency representative to the Committee on National Security Systems, and the Senior Information Sharing and Safeguarding Steering Committee.

Leo has worked at the interagency level as a co-chair of the Identity Credential and Access Management sub-committee of the Information Security and Identity Management Committee (ISIMC), and as a tri-chair of the ISIMC. He is a member of the Government Advisory Council of the International Information System Security Certification Consortium.
