### Assistant DNI for Information and Data

Ms. Nancy Ellis Morgan was appointed as the Assistant DNI for Information and Data (ADNI/I&D) in May 2019. She is dual hatted as the Intelligence Community Chief Data Officer (IC CDO), an executive-level position that is mandated by the U.S. Congress. In this role, Ms. Morgan is responsible for leading the IC's strategic initiative to re-imagine the future of the IC's data and information landscape in the digital era. Ms. Morgan also serves as the Intelligence Community Information Sharing & Safeguarding Executive (IC ISSE).

In her capacity as ADNI/I&D, Ms. Morgan is leading the IC's effort to ensure data that is collected, acquired or created is appropriately protected and can be shared to the maximum extent necessary at the speed of mission. As the IC CDO and IC ISSE, she is responsible for organizing and leveraging the efforts of data professionals across the IC to realize the vision of "Data as an IC Asset."

Ms. Morgan has a proven track record of success in the IC. She led numerous CIA and IC initiatives for more than twenty-five years, including several flagship programs related to information technology solutions. Such programs and solutions included those in research and analysis, enterprise data management, intelligence dissemination, targeting, identity, and access management, information management, information review and release, business systems, and imagery analysis.
