

Nicholas Lanham supports the DoD Chief Digital and AI Office (CDAO), Enterprise Capabilities Directorate as the Deputy Program Manager (DPM) for the Advana program. Lanham also leads the product management efforts aligned to the Deputy Secretary of Defense (DSD) Executive Analytic application suite and data acquisition efforts supported by the Advana program's Data as a Service (DaaS) team. This effort requires a close partnership with the DoD CDO, as well as each Service CDO, while working to iterate through one of the Department's largest data ingestion efforts.
