

Samuel Bendett

Associate Research Analyst, CNA Russia Studies Program

Samuel Bendett is an Associate Research Analyst with the Center for Naval Analyses' International Affairs Group, where he is a member of the CNA's Russia Studies Program. His work involves Russian defense and security technology and developments, Russian geopolitical influence in the former Soviet states, as well as Russian unmanned military systems development. As a native Russian speaker, he also takes an in-depth look at Russian naval capabilities and Russian decision-making calculus during military crises. Samuel participates in DoD-sponsored war games and table top exercises, and delivers classified and open briefings on Russian military capabilities and developments.

Samuel Bendett is also affiliated with the American Foreign Policy Council as a Fellow in Russia Studies. At AFPC, his research will involve Russian unmanned military systems, Russian military developments and doctrine, as well as Russian politics and decision-making.

Prior to joining CNA, he worked at the National Defense University (Washington, DC) on emerging and disruptive technologies for government response in crisis situations, where he conducted research on behalf of the Office of the Secretary of Defense for Policy (OSD-P) and Acquisition, Technology and Logistics (OSD-AT&L). He has facilitated DoD and interagency field experiments and technology demonstrations, and worked on advancing public-private partnerships across the Department of Defense. His NDU work also involved assistance on Russian military and security analysis for the US ARMY's Joint Warfare Analysis Center. His previous experience includes working for US Congress, private sector and non-profit organizations on foreign policy, international conflict resolution, defense and security issues.

Mr. Bendett's analyses and commentary on Russian military robotics and unmanned systems capabilities appear regularly in The National Interest. His views on Russian unmanned military systems also appear on DefenseOne, Breaking Defense, WarisBoring, and The Strategy Bridge. Mr. Bendett was a foreign policy and international affairs contributor to the RealClearWorld.com blog, writing on Russian military technology, including unmanned systems, socio-cultural developments across Former Soviet Union, as well as Russian foreign policy developments.

Mr. Bendett received his M.A. in Law and Diplomacy from the Fletcher School, Tufts University and B.A. in Politics and English from Brandeis University.
