Shawn Skelly serves as a Commissioner for the Military Service, National Commission on Military, National, and Public Service, an 11-member bipartisan commission tasked by Congress in 2017 to review the Selective Service System, along with military, national, and public service. Ms. Skelly previously served in the Obama Administration as the Director of the Office of the Executive Secretariat at the U.S. Department of Transportation, after serving as Special Assistant to the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition, Technology, and Logistics at the Department of Defense, as coordinator of the Department's Warfighter Senior Integration Group. In that role, she was responsible for facilitating the Department's response to the most urgent and unique support requirements of Combatant Commanders, including the Counter ISIL Campaign and operations in Afghanistan. Prior to joining the Obama Administration in 2013, she spent five years in industry with ITT Exelis.
