How do I register?

What is the cost of registration?

Federal, military, academic/think tank/NGO and media can register free of charge. Fees applicable for industry employees and retirees, based on the below amounts and pricing deadlines:

- Super Early Bird (before April 8): \$125
- Early Bird (before May 6): \$250
- Regular (before June 10): \$350
- Late (before June 27): \$450
- On-Site (June 27): \$550

Is there group pricing available?

Group pricing is available for those who register three or more people together in the same group. Group pricing rates can be found below. If your group is unable to register at the same time, please reach out to Leah Spinelli at lspinelli@govexec.com

- Super Early Bird (before April 8): \$99/person
- Early Bird (before May 6): \$199/person
- Regular (before June 10): \$299/person
- Late (before June 27): \$399/person
- On-Site (June 27): \$499/person

What kinds of payment do you accept?
