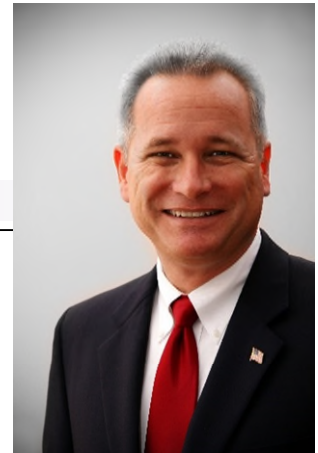


James A. “Tony” Buntyn, CISSP, ITIL v3
