Mr. Jeffrey S. Wilk was appointed to the Defense Intelligence Senior Level position of Senior Technical Officer for Cyber Network Defense on 29 July 2012.

As the Senior Technical Officer for Cyber Network Defense, he serves as the senior expert for information assurance (IA) and cyber security authority for the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) and Department of Defense Intelligence Information System (DoDIIS) global Information Technology (IT) operations and information systems.



Mr. Wilk participates in National and DoD senior-level IA activities for strategic planning initiatives, infrastructure, protection assessments, and develops technical and policy guidelines in support of agency mission and serves as the principal advisor to the Chief, Office of Cyber Security on cybersecurity issues for DIA, DoD and IC.

Prior to his present appointment, Mr. Wilk served the IC CIO as the Director, Intelligence Community – Incident Response Center (IC-IRC) for past three years. As the IC-IRC director, he coordinated activities for the integrated defense of the IC information environment with IC elements; the Department of Defense; and other U.S. Government departments and agencies. A 28 year career employee of DIA, all within the Directorate for Information Management and Chief Information Officer, he has held key leadership positions responsible for planning, maintaining, and operating enterprise information systems throughout DIA.

A native of Duluth, MN, Mr. Wilk holds a Bachelor of Arts from Gustavus Adolphus College, St. Peter MN. He has received the Director's Award for Exceptional Civilian Service, and the Presidents Council on Year 2000 Conversion Award.
